Promoting Public Access and Greenspace at the State Line Peninsula

CLC is supporting community-led advocacy to ensure redevelopment of Hammond's former State Line Energy plant site includes public lakefront access, greenspace, and environmentally responsible design.

What's at Stake

The former State Line Generating Plant was once a coal-fired power facility on a man-made peninsula along Lake Michigan. Since its closure in 2012, the site has been transitioning toward industrial redevelopment, including a large data center. That plan raises important questions about public access, environmental protection, and the future of a highly visible stretch of Indiana's lake Michigan shoreline.

CLC represents Friends of Veterans Memorial Park and supports community participation as redevelopment plans evolve. CLC is helping advance commitments for public access, greenspace integration, and environmentally responsible design.
